Mentoring Program	Program of a one-to-one relationship between the student and a lecture , that provides support, guidance and mentoring to the student in order to help it with their academic performance. Also, a local student knows as Buddy assists the international student to help with the integration into the local community.
Orientation Program	A Welcoming Day is offered to inform the international student about the university life, their mentors, buddies, calendars etc. It takes place a weekday before the classes commence and is mandatory to attend.
